

Carriage for Forklift

Carriage for Forklift - Rated by the fork carriage lifting capability, there are actually four sizings of hook type tine carriages. The hook type fork carriages have been standardized.

The carriage bar spacing for Class 1 is about thirteen inches and the Class 1 carriage is rated to carry cargo as much as 2000lbs. The Class 2 carriage is rated to carry cargo up to 5,500lbs with carriage bar spacing of sixteen inches. Class III carriages are rated for loads up to 10,000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this particular class is twenty inches. Class IV carriages are rated for loads as much as 15,500 lbs. The carriage bar spacing utilized for this capacity is twenty five inches.

The carriages for pin type tines could be different depending on the maker. Pin mounted tines can differ by the amount of offset between the blade eye and the fork. Carriage capacity will be established by the carriage pin size and by the fork size.
