

Side Tilt Carriage

Side Tilt Carriages - There are actually 4 sizes of hook type fork carriages rated by the tine carriage lifting capability. Hook type tine carriages have been consistent.

The carriage bar spacing for Class 1 is more or less 13 inches and the Class 1 carriage is rated to carry loads up to 2000lbs. The Class 2 carriage is rated to hold cargo as much as 5,500lbs with carriage bar spacing of sixteen inches. Class III carriages are rated for cargo up to 10,000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this particular class is 20 inches. Class IV carriages are rated for cargo up to 15,500 lbs. The carriage bar spacing utilized for this capacity is twenty five inches.

The carriages for pin type blades can be different depending on the maker. Pin mounted forks can differ by the amount of offset between the tine eye and the blade. Carriage capacity would be determined by the carriage pin size and by the fork size.
